**OPERATIONAL DIRECTIVE
No. 05 – 25/03/2020**

On establishment of certain restrictions in the field of civil aviation in order to prevent the spread of infection with new Coronavirus (2019- nCoV)

1. This Directive is issued in accordance with art.7 paragraph (3) 1) c) and d) of the Aviation Code of the Republic of Moldova no.301/2017, in order to implement the provisions of Decisions no.1-9 of the National extraordinary public health commission, issued during 2nd of February 2020 – 15th of March 2020 and the provisions of the Decision no.4/2020 of the Committee on exceptional situations of the Republic of Moldova.
2. Shall be suspended all passenger scheduled and nonscheduled flights to/from the Republic of Moldova.
3. Nonscheduled flights carrying on board passenger holding the citizenship of the Republic of Moldova, shall be authorized during the exceptional situation period by the Committee on exceptional situations of the Republic of Moldova, based on the request of the Civil Aviation Authority.
4. Air operators performing nonscheduled passenger flights to the Republic of Moldova during the exceptional situation period are prohibited to embark passengers of other citizenship, other than of the Republic of Moldova.
5. Stateless persons and foreign citizens with domicile, residence or residence permit in the Republic of Moldova, aircraft maintenance personal and crew members, as well as members of diplomatic missions and of accredited consular offices in the Republic of Moldova, members of international organizations/missions and their family members are excepted from provisions specified under point 4.
6. While carrying out their activity, the aeronautical agents shall comply with the Decisions of the National extraordinary public health commission as well as the Decisions of the Committee on exceptional situations of the Republic of Moldova that can be accessed on the website of the Government of the Republic of Moldova www.gov.md, section "Information regarding Coronavirus".
7. Non-compliance with the public health measures established through the Decisions specified under **point 6** may serve as basis for contravention/criminal offence.
8. This Operational Directive enters into force from the moment of its issuance and is published on the website of the Civil Aviation Authority, www.caa.md, section "Legal framework/Directives".
9. Operational Directive no.03-15/03/2020 and Operational Directive no.04-19/03/2020 shall be repealed.
10. This Directive shall be in force during the exceptional situation period, until 15th of May 2020, local time 23:59, with possibility to be extended.
